TDaP is a combined vaccine that prevents 3 diseases:



Tetanus (T):
causes painful muscle stiffness and
spasms. The bacteria that causes
it enters the body through
dirty wounds.



Diphtheria (D): causes difficulty in breathing, heart failure, paralysis, or death. It is transmitted through the air by close contact with an infected person.



Pertussis or Whooping Cough (aP): causes violent and uncontrollable coughing that makes it difficult to breathe, eat, or drink. It is transmitted from person to person through the air when an infected person speaks or coughs.
